Ink Cartridges- We are continuing our ink cartridge and cell phone recycling efforts. Please continue bringing them in!

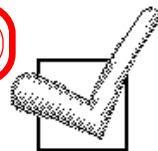
Aluminum Can recycling - I am tentatively planning to have the next aluminum can recycling Saturday, October 30th.
