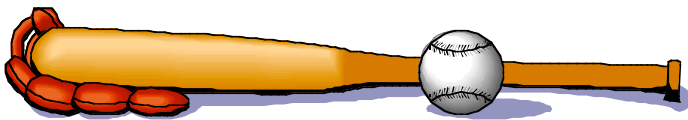
Scoutmaster Minute

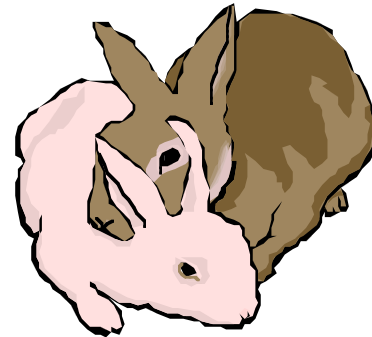
