Dear Troop,

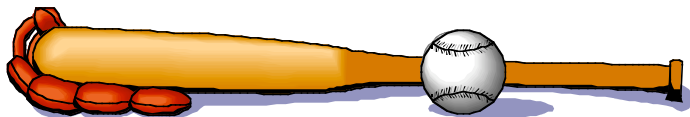
Everyone has heard the saying “do your best”. Well that is a good thing to live by. Here is another way to look at this.

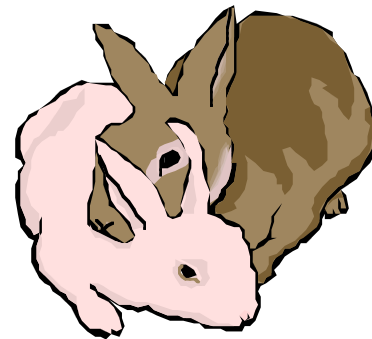
